

Decorating Ideas

Pictured below are just a few of the creative ways you can decorate your Gingerbread House to fit the season or occasion. Here are some seasonal tips that you may find helpful.

Halloween House

Scatter dried fruit bits around the base of the house to look like fallen leaves.

Cover snowman with icing to create a ghost shape.

Hang strands of white cotton candy across roof area to look like spider webs.

Birthday House

Turn snowman upside down and frost to make an ice cream cone shape.

Add colored birthday candles to the roofline.

Surround base of house with pink cotton candy for a festive look.

Easter House

Use Royal Icing to "glue" together 4 squares of breakfast cereal to form an Easter basket. Fill with small jelly beans.

Tint shredded coconut with green food coloring and sprinkle around the base of the house to resemble grass.

Try covering the roof with crackers or squares of breakfast cereal to create a shingled or thatched roof.



Christmas

Sprinkle marshmallows or shredded coconut around the base of the house to look like snow.

Cover an upside down ice cream cone with green frosting and decorate with candies for a large Christmas tree.

Turn one of the snowmen into a "snow lady" by adding an apron or a skirt using colored frosting.
