

Buffalo Chicken Dip



Ingredients:

2 12.5oz Cans Chunk Chicken Breast (Drained) or 3 Medium size Chicken Breasts
1 8oz Tub (softer than block) of Regular Cream Cheese
1 23 oz Bottle of Frank's Red Hot Sauce (*this can be substituted for other hot sauce*)
1 8 or 16oz Bottle of Ranch (**Preferred**) or Blue Cheese dressing
1 Shredded package or block of Cheddar Cheese



Preparation:

Preheat oven to 350° while preparing other parts of recipe
In one 2 cup prep bowl put 1 8oz Tub of cream cheese
In one 1 cup prep bowl put ½ cup of Frank's Red Hot sauce (less for mild)
In second 1 cup prep bowl put ½ cup of Ranch (**Preferred**) or Blue Cheese Dressing
In last 1 cup prep bowl put ½ cup of Cheddar cheese shredded by using either the Ultimate Mandoline, Rotary Grater, or packaged shredded cheese.



Place the cream cheese in Classic Batter bowl that is microwave safe and heat for about 1 min until softened. Then mix in Frank's Red Hot Sauce, Ranch or Blue Cheese dressing, and ½ cup of Cheddar cheese.



For quick and easy dip, use the canned chunk chicken breast by draining out the cans and placing it in the 2 qt Classic Batter Bowl with all the other ingredients. If you wish to make fresh chicken for the dip wash off the three chicken breasts and pat dry with paper towel. Then place the chicken in the Deep Covered Baker and microwave for 15 to 20 min ensuring the meat is thoroughly cooked. Then using the Salad Choppers, chop up the chicken into small shredded pieces. Then once you have shredded the chicken small, enough place it in the 2 qt Classic Batter Bowl with other ingredients. Using the Mix 'N Scraper, to combine all the ingredients together pour mixture into 9x9 Square Baker.



Top with more of the shredded Cheddar Cheese, then bake in oven for about 20 minutes.
Serving suggestions are with corn chips, tortilla chips, or celery sticks.

Note: Replacing some items with Lite or Fat Free products may reduce the calories in this dip.
