- Breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in women.
- Every year, an estimated 192,000 women in the U.S. are diagnosed with invasive breast cancer.
- Breast cancer death rates have declined by 2 percent per year since 1990, largely due to advances in treatment and early detection.
- There are approximately 2.5 million breast cancer survivors in the United States.
