

Making a parchment circle: step-by-step directions



1: For an easy way to make a Parchment Paper circle to line the bottom of a Torte Pan, start with a 15-inch square of Parchment Paper. Fold it in half, making sure the crease faces you.



2: Fold it in half again (from left to right) to form a square.



3: Fold the square in half diagonally to form a triangle by bringing the upper left hand corner down to meet the lower right hand corner. Be sure to keep the center of the paper as the point of the triangle.



4: Fold again to form a thinner triangle.



5: Measure four inches from the tip of the triangle and cut the excess parchment off using Kitchen Shears.



6: Open the parchment and place it on the bottom of the pan. Excess parchment can be used to line the edge of the serving platter when decorating the cake.


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
