House-warming gifts, birthday presents and even your own kitchen take on the warmth of spring with these bright ideas.

Citrus Towel Apron

Here's how to make this simple and creative apron, sure to add a splash of color to your kitchen:

1. Select ribbon $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch in width.
2. Measure waist with ribbon to decide appropriate length, making sure to leave enough extra ribbon to tie in a bow; cut.
3. Sew ribbon along the length of the seam side of the towel, running it evenly across so that apron strings are even on each side.



A Pitcher-Perfect Present

- Remove lid/plunger from pitcher.
- Set the Good Company® Tea tin in the bottom of the pitcher.
- Return the lid/plunger to the pitcher.
- Pull the pitcher's plunger handle all the way up.
- Slide lid up handle, leaving bottom of plunger resting on the tin.
- Fill small plastic bags with your favorite cookies, scones or mini-muffins and tie the bags closed with bright ribbons.
- Set bags in pitcher on top of plunger base and slide lid back down into place.
